- a. T-shirts for camp:**

 - e. Fundraising:**
 - i. Decided to Skip Trash bags this year. Will be doing two new fundraisers.
 - ii. An orange sale in the fall (before Thanksgiving), and a popcorn sale sometime during the winter(January-February?)
 - iii. One fundraiser should be just for the general fund. Another one should go towards a students bandcamp, this might help them sell more.
 - iv. Still working on the Color run in spring with cross country.
 - f. Concessions:**
 - i. CMU Dates: November 2nd if available.
 - ii. The school is taking over concession for sport boosters. Band will still be doing volleyball concessions, will have to figure out basketball.
 - iii. Aug 28 is the first date for volleyball concessions. Will get the bare minimum of food. Candy, drinks, and popcorn.

- iv. Donation for drinks by parents. 20 oz for sport drinks and 16 oz of water.
- v. Beth will be taking over concessions.

- iv. Shirts will be picked up sometime during camp.
- v. Parents will sign their kid out in the rehearsal hall and grab that students uniform if it is ready to go. Will also be hanging out parent shirt orders during this time.
- vi. Paul has the list of the drum major supplies and will be going shopping for them.

- b. Marching schedule is on the band calendar.
