

Band Booster Meeting 8/1/17

- 1 Call to Order:** Meeting was called to order by Lisa Gross at 6:39 pm.
Present in attendance: Lisa Gross, Penny Murphy, Laura Pfeiffelman, John Pfeiffelman, Beth Twynham, Paul Shimmons, Amber Breeden, Becca Gross, and Aubree Hooper.
- 2 Minutes from last meeting:** Beth made a motion and John seconded it to approve the minutes from last month's meeting. Motion carried
- 3 Correspondence:** Penny has received band camp payments. She also received an thank you from Andrew Pfeiffelman for the scholarship he received.
- 4 Financial Report:** Available balance \$5,796.30 in checking. Penny paid the portion Boosters contributed for Drum major camp. Fifty students have paid in full for band camp. There are still 20 students who owe some or all of the band camp amount. If a student does not go to band camp but participated in Marching band, they will owe Band Boosters \$45. This cost covers their t-shirt, black gloves for marching, and the marching band uniform cleaning. Students will not receive their t-shirt and gloves until they have paid the \$45. John made a motion and Beth seconded it to accept the financial report. Motion carried.
- 5 Band Director Report:** .
 - 1 Shari is undecided if she is going to be able to go to band camp at this point. Amber B will be there to help with Color Guard. There are currently 52 girls and 22 boys in marching band. Paul will be determining which grades will bunk together at band camp. Last year it was senior and sophomores together in a room and juniors and freshman.

 - 1 Shane S. at Farwell Buccilli's does shirts now. Paul has a design that he has given to Shane. The design will be on the front only. The cost for the shirts ranges from \$13 - \$20 depending on the size. Paul will place an order for the band members. Parents who wish to order a shirt will be charged \$20 which will cover setup fees and such.

2 Uniforms:

- 1 Helmets and Plumes have been ordered. Monday night of band camp John will go out to the Springs and fit all of the students. He will be taking the uniforms home to alter. Gloves and a few pairs of pants need to be ordered. Penny made a motion and Beth seconded it to order the needed pants and gloves.

3 Equipment/Trailer:

- 1 John noticed on the way in to the meeting that the spare tire was split. Penny made a motion and Beth seconded it for Paul to take it in to Bob's tire to be fixed.

4 Fundraising

- 1 Penny will check with Carrows and Witbecks to see if we could do a pie fundraiser through them. We would like to sell them in November and have them delivered/picked up the Monday of the week of Thanksgiving.
- 2 Bowl-a-thon- We will save this until the winter.
- 3 Bake Sale at Surrey Point-Tabled until the September meeting. We make a decent amount of money in a short period of time doing this.
- 4 Selling a product from books-Tabled for now.

5 Color Guard:

- 1 They have two songs done so far.
- 2 Final tryouts will be this upcoming week.

6 Chaperones:

- 1 Chaperones **must** go into the administration office to have a background check done. This must be done every year. The administration office is open M-F from 8-4. If you are chaperoning camp, or any other activity this upcoming year, you must go in and get this done otherwise you will not be allowed to chaperone.

- 1 Concessions is coming up quickly! There are volleyball concessions starting on August 23rd. Paul will be creating a sign up for parent volunteers and student volunteers.
