  - a. Checking available balance is \$10,918.83
  - b. Savings available balance is \$1,073.63

  - e. Total profit from volleyball concessions adds up to \$3394.25

    - i. There is also a basketball game at the same time.

      1. Cheryl made a motion for boosters to pay for half of the cost and Heather seconded it. Motion passed.

    - ii. Need 9 hotel rooms with 4 being adult rooms
      1. Adult rooms are \$100 each
        - a. Cody made a motion for boosters to pay for the adult's rooms and Heather seconded it.
    - iii. We will be going to the Kalamazoo Valley Museum, Kalamazoo Air Zoo, Guitar Center, and The Crossroads Mall
