 - a. Checking available balance is \$13,417.90
 - b. Savings balance is 1,073.63 with \$500 set aside for scholarships
 - c. Brass Band trip expenditures:
 - i. Kalamazoo Air Zoo \$200
 - ii. Hotel Rooms 645.15
 - iii. Tickets \$490
 - d. Giving Day brought in \$76.78
 - e. Concessions Nov 22 - Dec 30 netted a profit of \$1,998.69
 - f. Both of the scholarship forms from last year should be getting turned in soon
 - i. Maddie Emmendorfer and Braxton Hutchinson
 - g. Heather made a motion to accept the financial report and Cody seconded. Motion passed.
- 5. Band Director Report:**
 - a. March 7th will be the 8th-12th grade Pre-Festival concert with a parent meeting immediately afterwards
 - b. District 9 festival is at Lincoln-Alcona this year and we will be taking 9th-12th grade symphonic band
 - i. The band will be playing 3 pieces + sight reading
 - ii. Need chaperones for this
- 6. Committees:**
 - a. Fundraising:**
 - i. We would like to have T-Shirts made for the 30th year of Cabin Fever
 1. Performers on the back and Logo on the front
 2. We would hold a presale and then order when we have a number
 3. Sell for \$20
 - ii. Bake Sale at Jay's is tentatively November 11th this year - Opening weekend of rifle hunting season
 - iii. We will be selling Buccilli's Cards
 - iv. Grand Traverse Pie
 1. Waiting on administration approval, will hold for 2 weeks from March 3-13 tentatively with Easter delivery
 - v. Carrow's Hot Dog sale will be on Saturday May 27th and Friday September 1st
 - b. Equipment/Trailer:**
 - i. We need a sound system for Cabin Fever. Rough cost is about \$1,300
 1. April made a motion to buy this and Heather seconded. Motion passed.
 - ii. Beck's in St. Johns quoted us ~\$19,000 for a 28ft 2 axle aluminum trailer
 1. Going to look for some other quotes but so far that is our best option for a new trailer

- iii. **OLD PRICING** for our trailer ads was \$350 for a 24"x30" single color ad, \$450 for dual color. \$250 for a 12"x30" ad, and \$50 for your name on the back with 2" letters. Paul will find out what the current prices are for the vinyl work so we can update our prices.

 - 2. Need workers and will need an adult to run it on the 13th and 20th

- h. Hunter Taylor and Andy Frisch will be our MCs again this year
- i. Matt Moore will be returning this year, we've got about the same amount of performers

- a. Patricia Mangus has been elected as our treasurer. She will need to be added to the bank account and Katie Dunkle will need taken off. Paul Shimmons, Dakota Weldon, and April Frost will all need to stay on the account.
